

There were tough economic times but my father continued to work hard and persevere. When he wasn't working, he spent a lot of time with many family and friends. He was a member of the Famee Furlane Club of Toronto, The San Vito Club and served as past president for the Club Ricreativo San Quirinese.

My father was very proud of the accomplishments of our Friulan community and was honoured to be able to participate in giving back. He always believed in helping others regardless of his own challenges. Two prominent buildings in our community; St. Clare of Assisi Catholic Parish and the Villa Leonardo Gambin Long-Term Care facility stand tall today with the bricks donated by our family.

He was respectful to everyone; from not eating until everyone was seated at the dinner table to holding the door and saying "ladies first". He was a joker; his quirky one-liner jokes he shared with his grandchildren who still repeat them to this day. Family was very important to him. He always said "love each other and no fighting". Dad, you showed us how to live simply and with love and respect. Thank you for all you've taught me. May you enjoy all the dolci that the beautiful heavens have to offer.

#### **Iles Pol Bodetto**

On January 11, 2020, the Famèe Furlane lost Iles Pol Bodetto, a faithful Lifetime Member and Bon Furlan, husband to Liliana and father to Claudia, Bruno and Manuela, all active members of the club. Here is what they wrote about their beloved father:

Born August 19, 1934, in Braida, San Vito al Tagliamento, Iles was one of five children

born into a hard-working family of 'contadins'. On his 20th birthday he made the long and uncertain journey across the ocean in the hopes of finding better opportunities Canada.

Married to Liliana for 59 years, he and their family created a

welcoming home whose doors were always open to everyone. Dad was a wonderful role model, providing us with so many examples of what it means to be an honest, hard-working person and for the courage it took to come to Canada, learn a new language, use raw skills to learn the masterful trade of plastering and to run a successful business until the age of 82 -- always well respected by many in his trade.

Dad was a beacon of respect, always treating others as equals, no matter their race or their religion. When visiting job sites you could see him delivering and carrying materials on his shoulders, cleaning up debris – and never hesitated to pick up his tools and work alongside his men. Dad always taught us that we are all equal – no person is above another.

Dad loved life and lived every day to the fullest, always looking forward to the next 'fiesta', making sure his table at the Famèe Furlane was the one closest to the bar, and sure to end off the night with 'una risada', 'una cjiantada' or two or three well into the wee hours – always, 'in cjamò una!' before inviting the gang back home for more. The Pol Bodetto's may have been the last to arrive to a function, but they were definitely the last to leave as well.

Despite having completed only a 3rd grade education, dad was nonetheless an intellect. His insight and his perspective allowed him to carry a conversation of any nature. We valued and sought his advice often. He certainly loved his politics, soccer, cycling and Formula 1 and his Corriere Canadese. We valued and sought his advice often – right to his last weeks.

This tribute would not be complete without speaking of his generosity. He was a loyal supporter of many charitable organizations and was always prepared to offer help to those in need.

Despite his life-long health struggles, he persevered. In these last few years, he showed the most courage and strength. He is, always has been and always will be our hero. His advice to us was simple yet very profound:

On a lighter note, I am excited to announce the successful conclusion of our Better Bed Campaign. I would like to extend a special thanks to former Board Chair Jerry Buligan who conceived and initiated this campaign, the success of which far exceeded our expectations. Thanks to his leadership and passion, this initiative resulted in VLG's incidents of resident falls dropping to among the lowest in Ontario, truly making our home Best in Class!

I would also like to thank all of those in the community who helped us reach our goal. Whether by buying a bed, donating money towards a bed, attending our fundraising events, holding private events to raise money for the campaign, or our staff participating in payroll deductions to contribute to new beds, this was truly the effort of an entire community. You are the reason that our residents have more functional beds to keep them safe and comfortable, making a huge difference in the lives of those we serve.

Although the Better Beds Campaign is over, our aging facility is always in need of capital investment to keep the home functioning, looking great, and to improve our resident's quality of life by investing in enhancements throughout. Currently we are raising money to renovate the Activity Rooms on each resident floor.

We know that without our donors and volunteers we would not be able to accomplish these projects or provide the high level of care, services and programming that we do, and so we are truly thankful for the ongoing support. On behalf of our 168 residents, the Board of Directors, management and staff, thank you from the bottom of our hearts for your continued support and generosity!


